## **Totality a Block Party**

Monday, April 8, 2024 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.



The Bootheel Youth Museum will host a solar eclipse viewing party along with educational programs and hands on activities beginning at 11 a.m. This total eclipse will be the last one viewable from Missouri until 2178. The path of totality passes over Malden, MO on April 8, 2024 Staring at 12:40:04 p.m. ending at 1:57:11 p.m. Malden will be in darkness for 3 minutes 18 seconds this complete blocking of light from the moon is called: Totality. According to preventblindness.org exposing your eyes to the sun without proper eye protection during a solar eclipse can cause "eclipse blindness" or retinal burns, also known as solar retinopathy. This exposure to the light can cause damage or even destroy cells in the retina (the back of the eye) that transmit what you see to the brain. The BYM Giftshop will have certified safe eclipse viewing glasses and you'll be able to pickup free educational literature.
