

Ocean Steamer Sinks

Striking an iceburg, the Titanic, largest and finest passenger ship in the world, is reported to have sunk with its crew and passengers. 1525 being lost and some 675 being rescued by the Carpathia, who answered distress signals given by wireless telegraphy.

Among the passengers were many wealthy people, J. J. Astor and wife whose marriage last September caused so much criticism, being of the number. No doubt many more far more worthy of note than this beautiful brace were among the lost.

This is the greatest sea disaster ever known, if reports of number lost are true.

The Titanic was over 882 feet long and cost ten millions dollars, and was thought impossible to be sunk.
